Glorious Mystery

1st Mystery Resurrection

The angel said to the women, “Do not be afraid; for I know that you are looking for Jesus who has been crucified. He is not here, for He has risen, just as He said” (Matt. 28,5-6)



2nd Mystery Ascension into Heaven

So then, when the Lord Jesus had spoken to them. He was received up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God. (Mark 16-19)

3rd Mystery Descent of the Holy SPIRIT

And there appeared to them tongues of fire distributing themselves, and they rested on each one of them and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit was giving them utterance. (Acts. 2,3-4)

4th Mystery Assumption

For behold, from this time on all generations will count me blessed, For the Mighty One has done great things for me; And holy is His name. (Luke 1,48-49)

5th Mystery Crowning of our Blessed Lady

A great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet and on her head a crown of twelve stars.
(Revelation 12,1)

Joyful Mystery

1st Mystery ANNUNCIATION

And coming in, he said to her: "Greetings, favoured one!
The Lord is with you. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son and you shall name Him Jesus"
(Luke 1,28-31)



2nd Mystery VISITATION

When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby leaped in her womb; and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit. And she cried out with a loud voice and said, "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb!"
(Luke 1,41-42)

3rd Mystery Birth of Jesus

And she gave birth to her firstborn son; and she wrapped Him in cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.
(Luke 2,7)

4th Mystery Presentation in The Temple

And when the days for their purification according to the law of Moses were completed, they brought Him up to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord as it is written in the Law of the Lord, "every first-born male that opens the womb shall be called holy to the Lord" (Luke 2,22-23)

5th Myster Finding the Child Jesus

And He said to them, "Why is it that you were-looking for Me? Did you not know that I had to be in My Father's house? And He went down with them and came to Nazareth and He continued in subjection to them; and His mother treasured all these things in her heart
(Luke 2,49-51)

Luminous Mystery

1st Mystery Baptism in the Jordan

In those days Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. Immediately coming up out of the water, He saw the heavens pening, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon Him; and a voice came out of the heavens: "You are My beloved Son, in You I am well-pleased" (Mark 1,9-10)



2nd Mystery Wedding at Cana

On the third day there was a wedding in Coma of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there, and both Jesus and His disciples were invited to the wedding When the wine ran out, the mother of Jesus said to Him. They have no wine And Jesus said to her: "Woman, what does that have to do with us? My hour has not yet come". His mother said in the servants. Whatever He says to you, do it. and manifested His glory, and His disciples believed in Him. (John.21-5)

3rd Mystery Proclamation of the Kingdom

Jesus was going throughout all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness among the people. Large crowds followed Him from Galilee and the Decapolis and Jerusalem and Judea and from beyond the Jordan.
(Matt. 4,23,25)

4th Mystery Transfiguration

Six days later Jesus took with Him Peter and James and John his brother, and led them up on a high mountain by themselves and He was transfigured before them; and His face shone like the sun, and His garments became as white as light. And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Him. (Matt. 17,1-3)

5th Mystery Institution of the Eucharist

When the hour had come, He reclined at the table, and the apostles with Him, And He said to them, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer; for say to you, I shall never again eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God." (Luke 22,14-16)

Sorrowful Mysteries

1st Mystery Agony IN THE Garden

And being in agony He was praying very fervently; and His sweat became like drops of blood, falling down upon the ground,
(Luke 22,44)



2nd Mystery the Scourging at the Pillar

Wishing to satisfy the crowd, Pilate-released Barabbas for them, and after having Jesus scourged, he handed Him over to be crucified.
(Mark 15,15)

3rd Mystery Crowning with Thorns

And after twisting together a crown of thorns, they put it on His head, and a reed in His right hand; and they knelt down before Him and mocked Him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!" They spat on Him, and took the reed and began to beat Him on the head.
(Matt. 27,29-30)

4th Mystery Caring of the Cross

So, he then handed Him over to them to be crucified They took Jesus, therefore, and He went out, bearing His own cross, to the place called the Place of a Skull. which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha.
(John 19,16-17)

5th Mystery Crucifixion

Therefore, when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, 'It is finished!' And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.

(John 19,30)
